



Watlow has never carried out a shelf-life test but has advised that if the product is in its original sealed condition the inert contents would remain intact for a very long time.

Industry standards for heat transfer liquid suggest 5 years.

One point to note is, if the Watlube is left still for a long period of time the chemical compounds, used to create the product, can separate showing two distinct different colours in the container.

A distinct clear level can be observed on top.

This is not a problem as, before use, the recommended procedure is to thoroughly shake the bottle ensuring the relevant compounds are mixed.

This will show as a milky white colour when properly mixed.
